Throughout this period, he also served as Assistant Provincial Grand Master responsible for the South West Area of the Province. He was also a trustee of the Grand Charity travelling to London for meetings as required. #### First Appointments.

W. Bro. Kevin D. Head to **Past Assistant Grand Director of Ceremonies.**

W. Bro. Head was initiated into The Round Table Lodge 7619 in January 2001 and served as Master there in 2006. He was honoured with London Grand Rank in November 2013 and serves the Metropolitan Grand Lodge as a Visiting Officer.
