We invite you to a unique and thought-provoking evening to be held at the Sindlesham Masonic Centre, which will explore an aspect of Freemasonry for Berkshire Freemasons:

To receive a delivery of the Prestonian Lecture for 2018, "A good workman praises his tools: Masonic metaphors in Ancient Greece" by W Bro Christopher Noon, AGDC.

Summary:

The Prestonian Lecture is the only lecture given under the authority of the United Grand Lodge of England. William Preston (1742-1818), regarded as the foremost Masonic educator of his time, left a legacy to provide for an Annual Lectureship. This year's lecturer is W Br Christopher Noon, AGDC, an Oxfordshire Mason and secretary of Apollo University Lodge No. 357.

The official Prestonian Lecture is presented to only four lodges in the year, and the Berkshire Lodge of Enlightenment No. 9946 has been honoured by UGLE to receive one of those four official lectures.

The dining fee is £30, which includes the booklet of the lecture. If you do not intend to dine but would like a copy of the lecture booklet, please let the secretary know, so that W Bro. Noon can bring enough booklets. The price of the booklet is £5.
