The Committee of The Provincial Grand Charity – “The Tom Langton Fund” Meeting on Tuesday 27th November 201 considered 37 Applications from Lodges across the Province of which all were approved totalling £16249. The Grants will help numerous non-Masonic Charities supporting vulnerable people, including those with disabilities, disadvantage children, youth organisations, local churches and associations. At this Meeting the Fund reached £762,675 in Grants since was established in 1985 and over 1479 Charities and deserving causes have benefited as a result.
