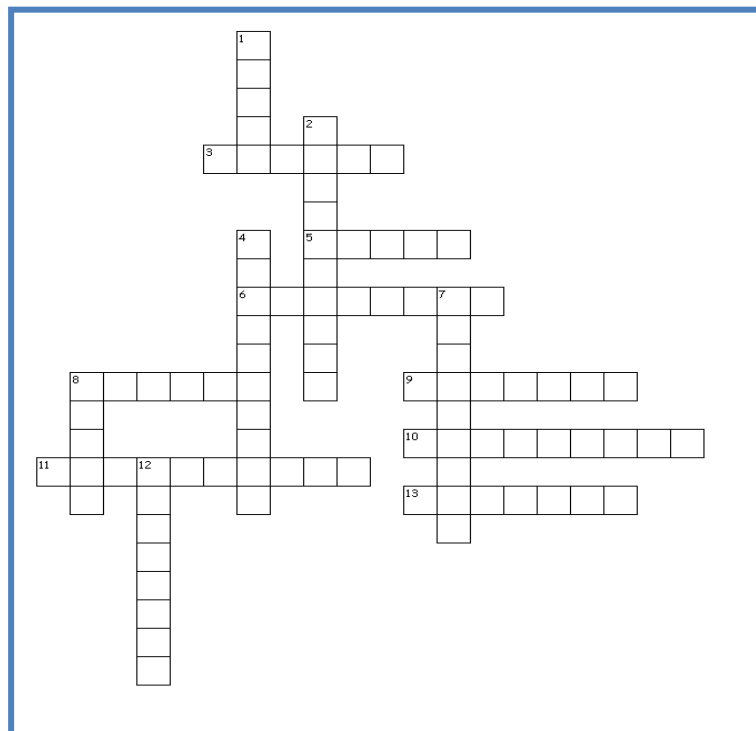
As the sun continues to shine, here's another Masonic Crossword for you to ponder upon!
